Other Site Characteristics

El edificio de la Iglesia Parroquial Nuestra Señora de la Asunción se encuentra dentro del casco urbano de Almodóvar del Campo, y el correspondiente a la Iglesia de Santa Catalina en el límite sur del casco urbano de Tirteafuera. Por tanto el paisaje es totalmente urbano en el primer caso y correspondería a un borde o ecotono de zona urbana y zona agrícola en el caso de Tirteafuera.

4.2 Quality and importance

La importancia de este espacio radica en las importantes colonias urbanas de cernícalo primilla. Según los datos oficiales del censo nacional de cernícalo primilla 2016, las colonias propuestas para su protección en el presente documento serían la cuarta (Almodóvar del Campo) y séptima (Tirteafuera) de Catilla-La Mancha en número de parejas reproductoras, que sumarían casi el 10% de la población reproductora de la provincia de Ciudad Real. Además se da la circunstancia de que la colonia de la Iglesia Parroquial de Nuestra Señora de la Asunción es una de las más antiguas documentadas en Castilla-La Mancha, con citas bibliográficas sobre esta colonia de cernícalo primilla anteriores a 1662
